Operation

The Middlesboro Independent School District, in collaboration with the Bell-Whitley Head Start, is a blended Preschool/Head Start Program serving approximately 100 children, with no more than 20 students per classroom.

Our classrooms are located in the Middlesboro Elementary building (formally known as West End). The classroom teachers and their assistants are employed by the Bell/Whitley Head Start Program.

In addition, Middlesboro Independent offers certified/licensed staff in special education, related services, and other individual needs. Our Preschool/Head Start students are instructed using Creative Curriculum, a comprehensive, research-based curriculum that features exploration and discovery as a way of learning.

Eligibility

Our Preschool/Head Start programs are available to:

- All income eligible 3 and 4-year old children; AND
- All 3 and 4-year old children with developmental delays or disabilities, regardless of income; AND

Other/Over Income 4-year old children as placements are available.
